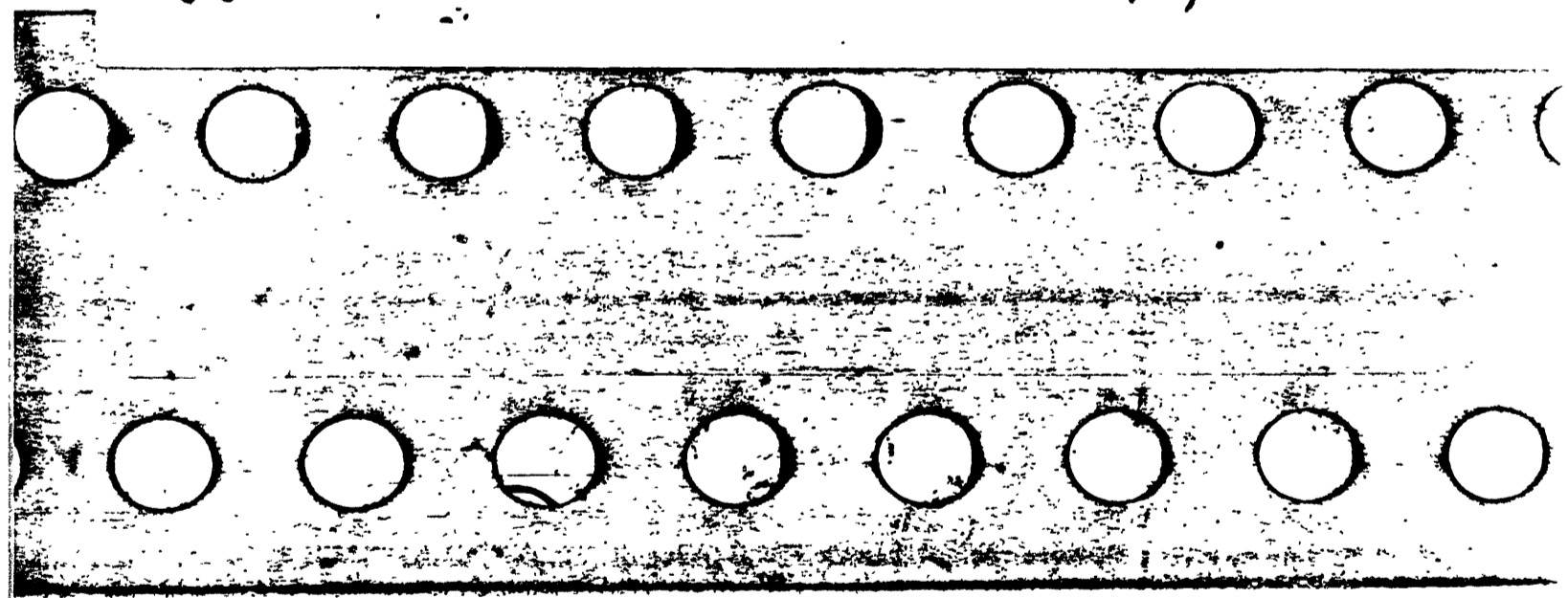

[REDACTED] advised on July 6, 1963, a meeting of the Albany Movement was held that date at the Shiloh Baptist Church, and approximately three hundred individuals attended. He stated SLATER KING, Vice President of the Albany Movement, and CHARLES SHERROD, Field Secretary for the Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee (SNCC), were the main speakers, and plans were formulated to stage demonstrations the afternoon of July 7, 1963, at swimming pool recently purchased from the city of Albany, Georgia, by JAMES H. GRAY, Editor and Publisher of "The Albany Herald Newspaper". He stated the swimming pool was formerly a part of Tift City Park, and scheduled to open as a private enterprise on July 7, 1963.

[REDACTED] advised on July 6, 1963, the United Klans of America met Southeast of Albany, Georgia City Limits the night of July 6, 1963. He estimated a crowd of approximately three hundred individuals gathered. He stated the meeting was addressed by [REDACTED], and Grand Dragon CALVIN CRAIG. He stated [REDACTED] discussed current Civil Rights legislation presently before Congress, and CRAIG discussed recent racial demonstrations in Savannah, Georgia, and encouraged whites to organize, and emphasized increased membership in the Ku Klux Klan.

[REDACTED] advised nine individuals consisting of two white male adults, two Negro male adults, one Negro female adult, and four Negro female juveniles were arrested on July 7, 1963, by the Albany, Georgia Police Department. He stated they were charged with loitering and refusing to obey orders of an officer at Tift Park Swimming Pool. He stated all persons arrested attempted to utilize the pool facilities, and were refused service, and when ordered to leave by police officers, they refused to do so, and were arrested. He stated cash bonds of two hundred dollars would be set on all those arrested except [REDACTED]

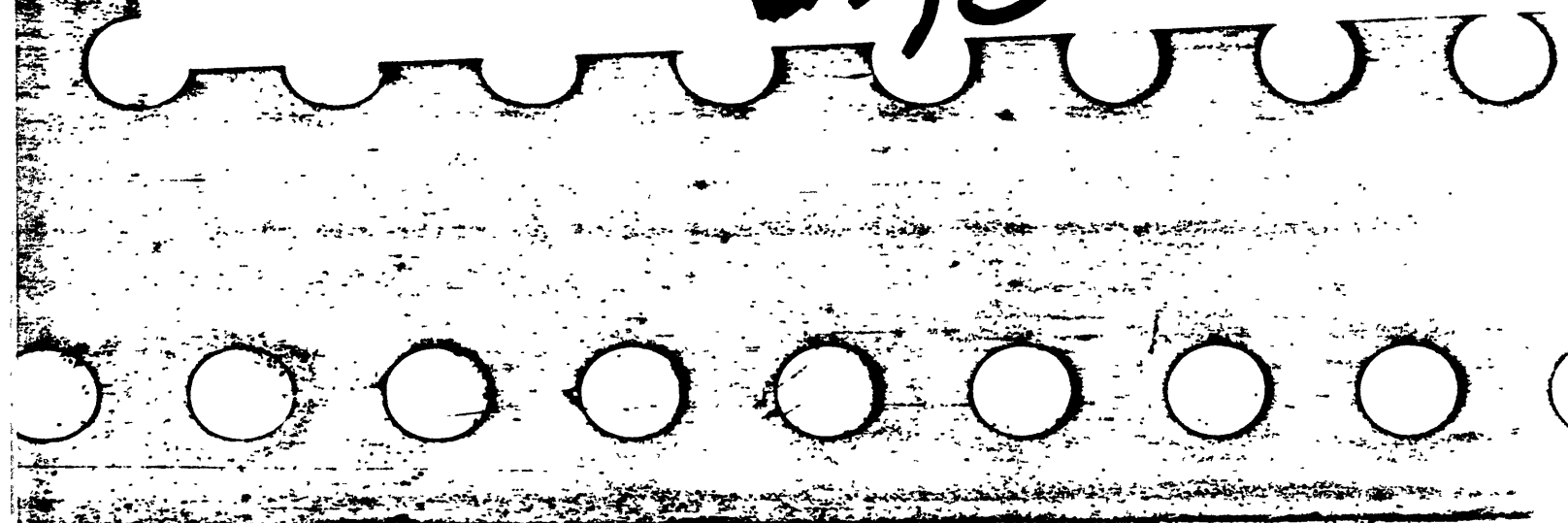

[redacted] furnished the following information concerning arrests made at former Tift Park swimming pool on July 7, 1963:

He stated the four juveniles arrested were released to their parents, and the five adults arrested remained in jail in lieu of two hundred dollars bond.

[redacted] advised a meeting of the Albany Movement was held the night of July 8, 1963, at Beulah Baptist Church. Approximately five hundred individuals attended. He stated MARION S. PAGE, official Albany Movement, encouraged tighter boycott of downtown merchants, and CHARLES SHERROD, Field Secretary, Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee, denounced small demonstrations in the past, and encouraged larger demonstrations. Reverend SAMUEL B. WELLS announced he was leaving the meeting to protest the arrest on July 7, 1963, of Albany Movement official, SLATER KING, at the swimming pool, which was formerly part of Tift City Park.

CHARLES SHERROD joined WELLS, and accompanied by fourteen other persons, all Negroes, congregated before the Albany City Hall at 10:20 p.m., July 8, 1963, and were met by [redacted]

[redacted] stated WELLS acted as spokesman for the group, stating they desired to meet with the Chief of Police or City Commission "to protest arrest of SLATER KING and selling of our swimming pools from the City Parks". [redacted] advised the group that neither the Chief of Police nor the City Commission were at City Hall, and requested the group to disperse and return the next morning. He stated the group stood mute, and he requested the group to disperse on three separate occasions. He then stated that three persons voluntarily left, and the remainder stood mute. He stated thirteen persons consisting of four adults, and nine juveniles were arrested for Disorderly Conduct and failing to obey officers. [redacted] stated at 10:30 p.m., approximately one-half of the group laid

down on the sidewalk, requiring the police to carry them to jail.

(7C) [REDACTED] 111th Intelligence Corps, was advised of the above at 1:30 a.m., July 9, 1963.

78 7D [REDACTED] advised SLATER KING, official of the Albany Movement, was convicted for failure to obey an officer, and loitering on private property, and was sentenced to sixty days in Recorder's Court before Judge A. N. DURDEN.

[REDACTED] were convicted on the same charges as KING, each being sentenced to \$102.00 fine or thirty days in jail. CA

[REDACTED] was convicted of violation of his sixty day probation, and sentenced to fifty-five days.

[REDACTED] stated the above convictions were the result of their anti-segregation activities.

[REDACTED] stated there were no other racial incidents, on July 9, 1963.

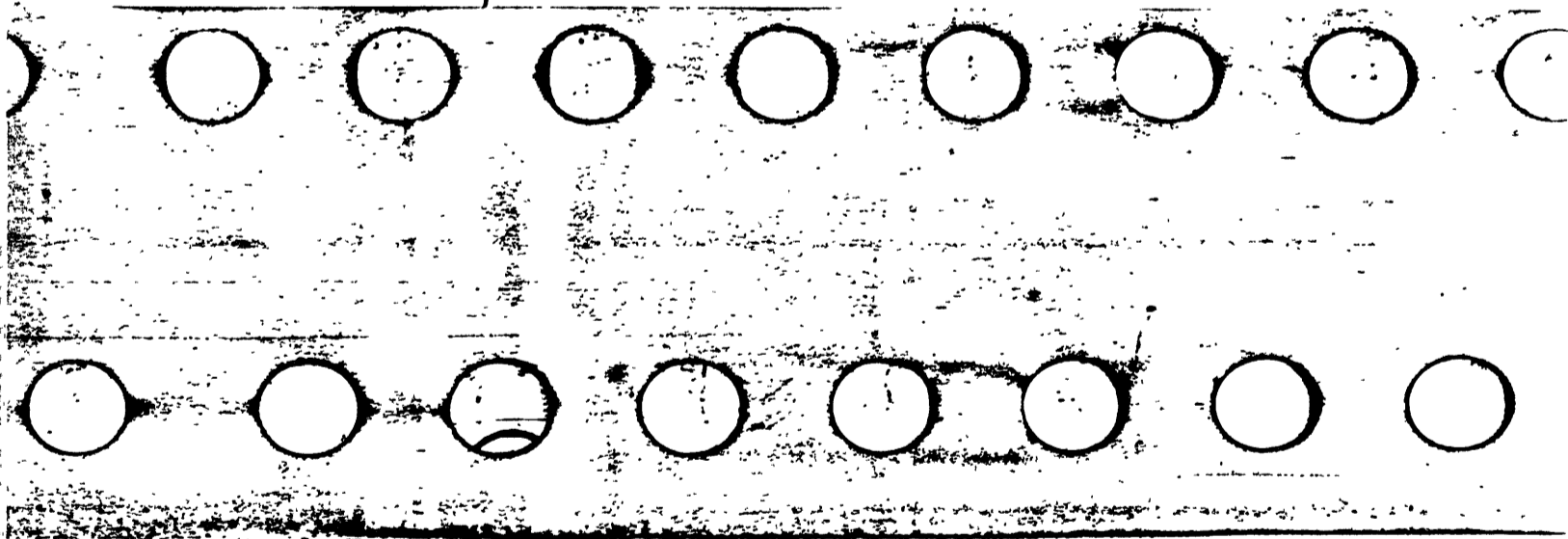

Wells and Slater King, Vice President, addressed the meeting. They encouraged larger attendance at meetings, and increased participation in racial demonstrations. Reverend Wells stated demonstrations will continue at the private swimming pool, which was formerly part of Tift City Park. There was no announced meeting until July 15, 1963.

[redacted] 111th Intelligence Corps, Fort McPherson, Georgia, was advised of the above on July 12, 1963.

[redacted] advised six persons were arrested July 13, 1963, attempting to gain entry into private swimming pool, formerly part of Tift City Park. The group included one white female adult, two Negro female adults, one Negro male adult, and two Negro juveniles. All were charged with loitering and failure to obey an officer.

[redacted] stated five Negro juveniles were arrested picketing in front of the residence of [redacted] a white business leader. They were charged with Disorderly Conduct and failure to obey an officer. The pickets carried signs reading "My Daddy can't afford a Ford", and "Return our stolen pool".

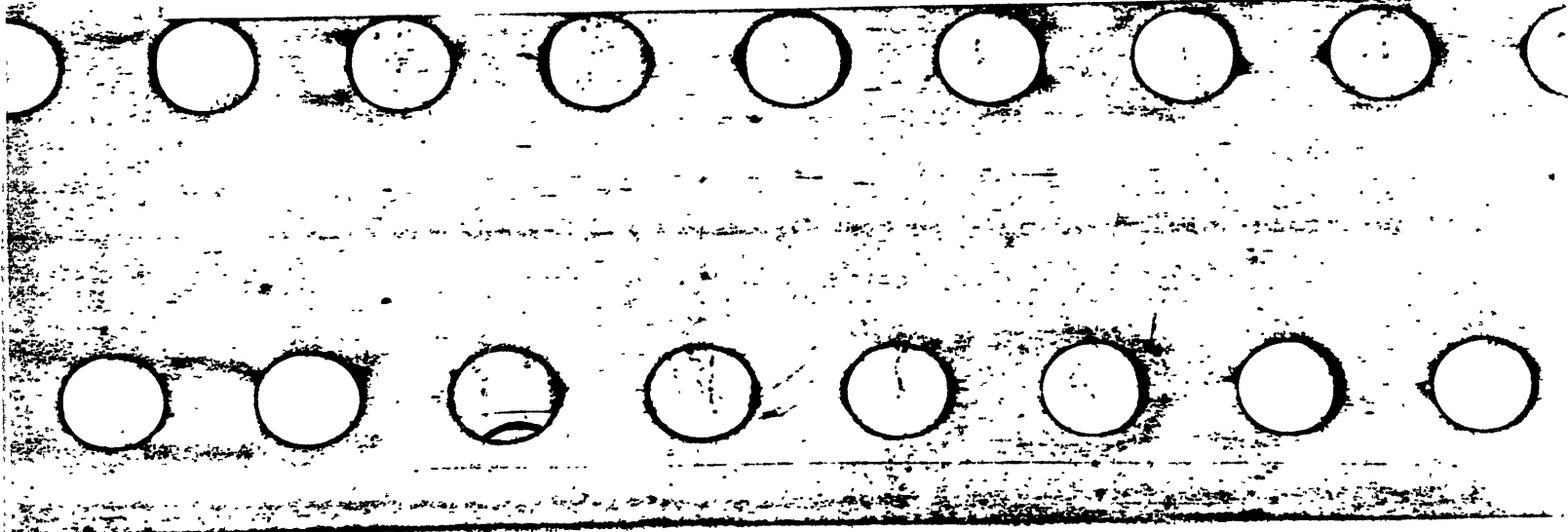

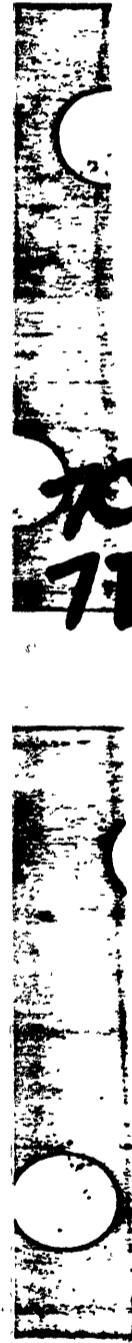

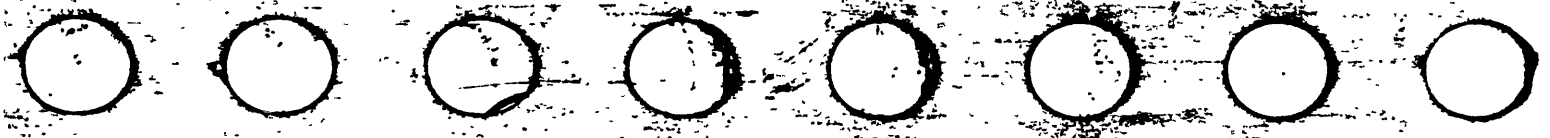

The only sites mentioned as targets were swimming pool at former Tift City Park, and downtown white merchants. Charles Sherrod, Field Secretary, Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee, discussed the planned demonstration at Washington, D. C., on August 28, 1963. It was announced that fares for volunteers would be paid, and persons attending meeting were requested to solicit volunteers. There were no arrests.

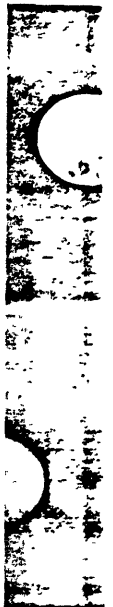

Results of examination:

Specimen Q1 is similar to a .22 Long Rifle caliber lead bullet manufactured by Winchester-Western. This bullet was fired from a barrel rifled with six lands and grooves. Because of the extensive mutilation of this bullet it was not possible to determine the direction of twist of the rifling. The number and width of the land and groove impressions appearing on specimen Q1 are similar to those produced by a large number of popular brands of American and foreign-made hand and shoulder weapons.

There are not sufficient microscopic marks remaining on specimen Q1 to identify the specific weapon from which it was fired. However, the few marks remaining on this specimen may be of value to eliminate suspect weapons which may be recovered.

Specimen Q2 is similar to a .22 Long Rifle caliber lead bullet. This bullet has been mutilated to the extent that it is of no value for identification purposes.

The group further requested the release of bonds for demonstrators arrested during recent anti-segregation demonstrations, desegregation of public accommodations, and consideration of qualified Negroes for city jobs. The request for the creation of a bi-racial committee was declined on the basis it was not a policy to "sanction or appoint any committee outside the Commission on matters relating to City business". 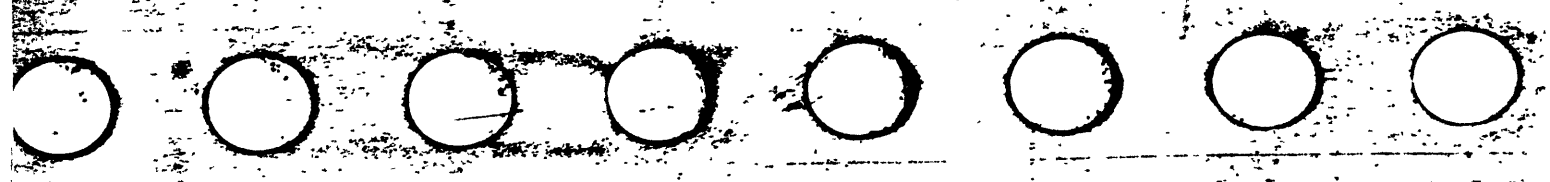
