AN ACT

To repeal the fugitive slave act of eighteen hundred and fifty, and all acts and parts of acts for the rendition of fugitive slaves.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 That sections three and four of an act entitled "An act re-4 specting fugitives from justice and persons escaping from the service of their masters," passed February twelve, seventeen 5hundred and ninety-three, and an act entitled "An act to 6 amend, and supplementary to, the act entitled 'An act re-7 specting fugitives from justice, and persons escaping from the 8 service of their masters,' passed February twelve, seventeen 9 hundred and ninety-three," passed September, eighteen hun-10 11 dred and fifty, be, and the same are hereby, repealed.
