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**AN ACT**

To repeal the fugitive slave act of eighteen hundred and fifty, and all acts and parts of acts for the rendition of fugitive slaves.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That sections three and four of an act entitled "An act re-  
4       specting fugitives from justice and persons escaping from the  
5       service of their masters," passed February twelve, seventeen  
6       hundred and ninety-three, and an act entitled "An act to  
7       amend, and supplementary to, the act entitled 'An act re-  
8       specting fugitives from justice, and persons escaping from the  
9       service of their masters,' passed February twelve, seventeen  
10      hundred and ninety-three," passed September, eighteen hun-  
11      dred and fifty, be, and the same are hereby, repealed.
