Mr. O'HARA introduced the following bill:

A BILL

Authorizing a reappraisement of the steam transport-boat Planter, captured by Robert Smalls, and for a distribution of proceeds thereof.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the Secretary of the Navy be, and he is hereby, author-
- 4 ized to appoint a board of competent officers of the Navy
- 5 whose duty it shall be to make a reappraisement of the steam
- 6 transport-boat Planter, taken during the late rebellion by
- 7 Robert Smalls from the harbor of Charleston, South Carolina,
- 8 and of all the arms, ordnance, ordnance stores, munitions,
- 9 tackle, and other property on board of said transport-boat at
- 10 the time of her delivery to the Federal authorities by the said
- 11 Robert Smalls; and when the full value of said transport-
- 12 boat, the arms, munitions, tackle, and other property, shall be
- 13 ascertained, estimating said values by the worth of the prop-

- 14 erty at the time of capture as aforesaid, shall cause an appor-
- 15 tionment of such value so ascertained to be made between
- 16 Robert Smalls and his associates on said transport-boat at the
- 17 time of her capture and delivery to the Federal authorities, in
- 18 the manner hereinafter provided for by this act, deducting only
- 19 the amount or amounts paid to the said Smalls and his said
- 20 associates under the act of Congress approved May thirtieth,
- 21 eighteen hundred and sixty-two.
 - 1 SEC. 2. That the apportionment referred to in the first
 - 2 section of this act shall be made as follows: One-third of the
 - 3 full amount of the value of the said transport-boat Planter,
 - 4 the arms, ordnance, ordnance stores, tackle, and other prop-
 - 5 erty, at the time of her capture and delivery to the Federal
 - 6 authorities, shall be awarded to the said Robert Smalls, and
 - 7 the balance shall be equally divided between his said asso-
 - 8 ciates or their heirs-at-law.
 - 1 Sec. 3. That the Secretary of the Treasury is hereby
 - 2 authorized and directed to pay to Robert Smalls and his asso-
 - 3 ciates, or their heirs-at-law as aforesaid, out of any money in
 - 4 the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum which may
 - 5 be by the said board of officers hereby authorized apportioned
 - 6 to each of them under the provisions of this act.
